

PARISH DEFIBRILLATOR UPDATE

In September the Government awarded £1million to the British Heart Foundation (BHF) for Community Defibrillators. Urchfont Parish Council (UPC) were invited to apply for grants for the Parish to improve our overall 24/7 coverage.

The Parish currently has two external defibrillators, one outside the Community Shop and one at Wedhampton providing 24/7 access; plus two internal defibrillators, one at the Village Hall and one at Planks Farm Shop available only during opening times.

Two Grant Applications were submitted and UPC are delighted to say that they have been awarded both!

1. An External Cabinet and Defibrillator to be installed around Townsend location, exact position to be determined.
2. Two External Cabinets to house the two BHS Defibrillators , one in the Village Hall porch and the other outside Planks Farm Shop, so providing 24/7 access to the surrounding areas.

In addition UPC are required to provide CPR Training. All the necessary equipment has been provided by BHF and details of the **FREE TRAINING** sessions are listed below.
