**MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2015**

The above Order made on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2015, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the footpath from OS Grid Reference SU0371-5708 at its junction with road C253 at The Top Green Urchfont leading generally west for 54 metres then continuing in a general north westerly direction to OS Grid Reference SU0362-5712 in the recreation field having a width of 1.5 metres from road C253 leading westerly for approximately 54 metres continuing with a width of 2 metres to OS Grid Reference SU0362-5712 with the limitation or condition of gates at OS Grid References SU0371-5708 and SU0366-5707.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to Ms B Burke, Rights of Way, Waste and Environment, Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8JN, not later than 5:00pm on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2015, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Wiltshire Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
