

**Section 106 Grant(s)
available
for Urchfont Parish**

The Manor Farmyard development will attract Section 106 Recreation funds of £56,430. The funds will be held by Wiltshire Council who will work with Urchfont Parish Council to identify suitable project(s) that satisfy any clause within the Section 106 agreement.

50% of these funds will become available when the 7th Market Housing unit (i.e. not affordable unit) is completed and 50% when the 13th Market Housing unit is completed.

There is therefore some time to develop an organised approach to gaining these funds.

The following are examples given by Wiltshire Council of what probably may be allowed:

Primary/Pre-School Age Children	Secondary School Age Children
Children's Play Equipment/Play grounds	Skateboard Parks
Grassed Areas for General Play	Multi Use Games Areas, for example rebound walls and Basketball courts/ hoops, Tennis Court within MUGA
Land purchase for Equipped Children's Play Areas	Fencing around Recreation Grounds and Play Areas.
Fencing around Recreation Grounds and Play Areas	Traditional Play Aimed at Older Children
Improved access to increase use including disabled	Goal Posts for Casual Use
	Improved access to increase use including disabled

The following are examples of what probably may not be allowed:

Maintenance	Bus Stops	Extensions to Village Halls
Bins for Village Greens	General fencing - maintenance	Speed humps
Indoor recreation / Community	Repairs	Salaries
Project management	Tables and Chairs	Formal Football pitch, Cricket Pitch, stand alone Tennis Court
